## **Inaugural Volleyball Hall of Fame Boys High School All-Star Match & Skills Competition Announced.**

**HOLYOKE, Mass. (June 15, 2012)** – The Volleyball Hall of Fame is proud to announce the Inaugural Western Massachusetts Boys High School Volleyball All-Star Team.

The 24 players selected for this honor represent 11 schools from throughout Western Massachusetts. Each of the players will be invited to play in the Inaugural Volleyball Hall of Fame All-Star Volleyball Match & Skills Competition presented by Whip's Sporting Goods, Under Armour, and the Pioneer Valley Volleyball Academy.

The event will be held at Agawam High School on Friday, June 22nd and will be free to attend. The Skills Competition will begin at 6pm followed by the All-Star Match at 7pm.

"I think it's important the Hall of Fame recognize the finest athletes not only internationally, but on the local level as well," said VHF Executive Director George Mulry. "There are some great things going on in Western Massachusetts volleyball and that should be celebrated."
